LOGISTICAL INFORMATION

1.) COURSE START

The course will start on Tuesday, 12 February 2019 at 9.00 at a hotel (TBC) in Nairobi, Kenya. The course ends on Friday, 15 February 2018 at around 16.30.

2.) TRAVEL TO NAIROBI

a) Flights

Travel costs must be borne by the participant.

b) Immigration

Please make sure to have all required travel documents (valid passport, with visa if applicable) at hand when you arrive and pass the immigration control.

In case you plan to stay in the region as tourist after the end of the programme, please make sure that you have already made necessary arrangements (bookings, visa that also covers the additional time you want to spend in this country etc.).

c) Transfer to venue on Monday, 11 February. Please let us know as soon as possible after you have been selected as a participant if you need support with arranging a transfer from Nairobi Airport to the hotel.

3) VENUE AND ACCOMMODATION

The course will take place at a hotel (TBD) in Nairobi, Kenya. Once you have been selected, please let us know as soon as possible if you will be staying at the venue or if you will arrange your own accommodation at your own expenses. We will send a registration link to all selected participants where they can provide this information.

All meals during the training will be organised for you. Please refer to the agenda (lunch and coffee breaks will be served each day). If you have any special needs (medical, dietary, etc.) please let us know so that we can make the necessary arrangements.

Wi-fi is available at the hotel.

4) INSURANCE & LIABILITY - MEDICAL ISSUES

CEP cannot provide any insurance coverage and declares explicitly that both participation in the course as well as the necessary stay at the training facilities are at the own risk of the participants.
